Arts and Crafts Exhibitor Application

ARTS AND CRAFTS DESIGNATION: Within the arts and crafts category, all items sold must be individually handmade by the artist/crafter represented, without the use of commercial molds, kits, casting patterns, or mass-produced parts.

- **Items for sale by Arts & Crafts Vendors shall be handmade. No Buy/Resale. No exceptions.**

WHERE: Downtown Racine, Main and Sixth Streets

WHEN: Saturday, September 21, 2019: 12:00 pm – 7:00 pm

SET-UP: 8:00am on day of event. Vehicles **MUST** be moved out of festival grounds by 11:00am

DEADLINE: All applications **MUST** be submitted by 4:00pm on August 23, 2019.

BOOTH SPACE: Booth space is limited to a single 12' x 12' booth (including all wires, stakes, poles, etc.). Vendors should come prepared for all types of weather. You must secure your booth in case of inclement conditions. ALL vendors are responsible for booth supplies (tables, chairs, tent, etc.). Electricity is limited, so plan on not having access to a power source.

EXHIBIT: All items being exhibited or displayed **MUST** be contained in the booth space assigned. No items, solicitation, or set-up shall take place outside the assigned booth space.

WEATHER: The Festival will not be cancelled because of rain. This is an outdoor event; be prepared for any type of weather. Tents, canopies and pop-ups must be secured to withstand the weather.

REQUIREMENTS: The vendor will be responsible to be open during the entire Festival. You cannot vacate early. Your booth must be neat, attractive and well-maintained. You are responsible for setting up, maintaining, and removing your own booth, your merchandise and your trash.

GENERAL INFORMATION - Procedures, Conditions & Rates

This document contains pertinent rules and regulations that govern the operations of Party on the Pavement (POP) sponsored and hosted by the Downtown Racine Corporation (DRC).

We are extending invitations to exhibitors who submit fully executed applications with required enclosures and payments (see application page) by the August 23, 2019 deadline. Priorities for space will be reviewed based on past participation, date of receipt of fully executed application and type of exhibit/activity.

DRC strives to maintain a balance and diversity in vendor offerings. All vendors and applications are reviewed so that we may maintain this balance. Our goal is to keep standards high and promote a safe, successful and fun festival. The policies and regulations set forth in this document are designed to maintain order and to regulate activities on the festival site. Regulations will be enforced.

PROCEDURES

The following application and agreement must be fully completed, signed and returned with the following enclosures in order to be considered for participation:

1. Detailed list of all proposed merchandise sold at Arts and Crafts booth space.
2. \$50.00 vendor fee with a completed and signed application by August 23, 2019. If the Arts and Crafts vendor fee is not paid by August 23, 2019, the exhibitor fee will be \$100.
3. Signed and dated AFFIRMATION & LIABILITY RELEASE

CONDITIONS

1. All locations will be assigned by DRC staff and POP volunteers. While written location requests will be considered, placement will be at the sole discretion of DRC staff and POP volunteers. Use of festival space is strictly limited to assigned location. All locations are subject to change and vendors may be asked to change locations on the day of the event.
2. With the exception of specified setup/load-in and breakdown/load-out times, vehicles will not be permitted in the event site. Vehicles will be removed immediately when asked to be by DRC staff and POP volunteers.
3. No Vendor Shall:
 - a. Attract attention to his booth by hawking or crying out.
 - b. Allow any waste, garbage or any other refuse to remain in or near his space after the closing hours of the POP Festival.
4. Exhibitors are not to begin tearing down their display until Saturday at 7:00 p.m. Booths must remain open until event closing. Leaving early makes the festival look in disarray; and exhibitors who leave early will not be invited to participate in the future.
