

WHY DOWNTOWN RACINE?

Incredible retail growth over the past two years and pending major housing and hotels developments have prompted downtown's "Racine-aissance." The boom began in 2018 with 23 new business openings and another 24 new restaurants, shops and service companies filling once empty storefronts with new vibrancy. Downtown Racine is now home to more than 40 restaurants, pubs and coffeehouses, over 50 retail shops and galleries and three museums. More than 120 days of events draw regional traffic to downtown, further expanding the local customer base.

Downtown Racine is conveniently located in the heart of the city along the shores of Lake Michigan and conveniently located within the Chicago/Milwaukee corridor.


BUSINESS MIX

RESIDENTIAL MARKET

Downtown's adjacent proximity to the waterfront creates an attractive place to live. Residential options include lake view high rises, historic loft apartments and live-work opportunities.

In addition, 3 market rate housing developers are breaking ground in 2020 which will be creating 1,000 housing units.

BUSINESS ASSISTANCE

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

Downtown Racine Corporation promotes a public-private model for downtown revitalization. Together with our partners, the DRC has made downtown a safe place to invest.

Private Investment in 2019: \$1.8 million

Buildings Renovated in 2019: 31

Public Investment in 2019: \$300,000
