Commercial Vendor Application

COMMERCIAL VENDOR APPLICATION: A commercial vendor is any vendor engaged in the sale of goods, services, wares, or merchandise, including food products. Commercial booth spaces are for businesses to promote and demonstrate products, services or distribute information.

WHERE: Downtown Racine, Main and Sixth Streets

WHEN: Saturday, September 18, 2021 12:00pm - 7:00 pm

SET-UP: 8:00am on the day of event. Vehicles MUST be moved out of festival grounds by 11:00am

DEADLINE: All applications **MUST** be submitted by 4:00pm on August 13, 2021

BOOTHSPACE: Booth space is limited to a single 12' X 12' booth (including all wires, stakes, poles, etc.). Vendors should come prepared for all types of weather. You must secure your booth in case of inclement conditions. ALL vendors are responsible for booth supplies (tables, chairs, tent, etc.). Electricity is limited, so plan on not having access to a power source.

EXHIBIT: All items being exhibited or displayed **MUST** be contained in the booth space. No items, solicitation, or set-up shall take place outside the assigned booth space.

WEATHER: Party on the Pavement will not be cancelled because of rain. This is an outside event so be prepared for any type of weather. Tents, canopies and pop-ups must be secured to withstand the weather.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE: A current Certificate of Insurance is required for all vendors naming Downtown Racine Corporation as an additional insured. The Certificate of Insurance is required before set-up. Contact your insurance company to acquire a Certificate of Insurance.

REQUIREMENTS: The vendor will be responsible to be open during the entire event. You cannot vacate early. Your booth must be neat, attractive and well-maintained. You are responsible for setting up, maintaining and removing your own booth, your merchandise and your trash.

GENERAL INFORMATION – Procedures, Conditions & Rates

This document contains pertinent rules and regulations that govern the operations of Party on the Pavement (POP) sponsored and hosted by the Downtown Racine Corporation (DRC).

We are extending invitations to exhibitors who submit fully executed applications with required enclosures and payments (see application page) by the August 13, 2021 deadline. Priorities for space will be reviewed based on past participation, date of receipt of fully executed application and type of exhibit/activity.

DRC strives to maintain a balance and diversity in exhibitor offerings. All exhibitors and applications are reviewed so that we may maintain this balance. Our goal is to keep standards high and promote a safe, successful and fun festival. The policies and regulations set forth in this document are designed to maintain order and to regulate activities on the festival site. Regulations will be enforced.

PROCEDURES

The following application and agreement must be fully completed, signed and returned with the following enclosures in order to be considered for participation:

- 1. Detailed list of all proposed merchandise sold, or activities to occur, at Commercial Vendor booth space.
- 2. \$300 vendor fee with a completed and signed application by August 13, 2021. If the Commercial vendor fee is not paid by August 13, 2021, the exhibitor fee will be \$400.
- 3. Certificate of Insurance naming Downtown Racine Corporation as an additional insured.
- 4. Signed and dated AFFIRMATION & LIABILITY RELEASE

CONDITIONS

- 1. All locations will be assigned by DRC staff and POP volunteers. While written location requests will be considered, placement will be at the sole discretion of DRC staff and POP volunteers. Use of festival space is strictly limited to assigned location. All locations are subjected to change and vendors may be asked to change locations on the day of the event.
- 2. With the exception of setup/load-in and breakdown/load-out times, vehicles will not be permitted in the event site. Vehicles will be removed immediately when asked to by DRC staff and POP volunteers.
- 3. No Exhibitor Shall:
 - a. Attract attention to his booth by hawking or crying out.
 - b. Allow any waste, garbage or any other refuse to remain in or near his space after the closing hours of the POP festival.
- 4. Exhibitors are not to begin tearing down their display until Saturday at 7:00 p.m. Booths must remain open until events closing. Leaving early makes the festival look in disarray; and exhibitors who leave early will not be invited to participate in the future.
